

**RICHMOND CITY  
2021 NOTICE OF ELECTION**

Richmond City will hold its Municipal Election this fall to elect a Mayor and two (2) Council Members.

The Primary Election date is Tuesday, August 10, 2021; if needed. The General Election will be held on Tuesday, November 2, 2021.

Mayor and Council Members serve four (4) year terms and are elected at-large.

The incumbents are:

Mayor: Jeffrey D. Young

Council Member: Lyle Bair

Council Member: Cheryl Peck

Those interested in filing for one of these offices must: Be a United States citizen at the time of filing, Be a registered voter of Richmond City, Be at least 18 years old, Be a resident of Richmond City for at least 365 days immediately preceding the date of the of the general election, November 2, 2021 and not be a convicted felon.

Candidate filing period begins on Tuesday, June 1, 2021 and ends on Monday, June 7, 2021.

Each person seeking to become a candidate for a municipal office shall file a Declaration of Candidacy in person with the City Recorder, 90 South 100 West, Richmond, Utah, during regular office hours but not later than 5:00 P.M. on Monday, June 7, 2021. The appropriate filing form is available at the City Recorder's Office.
