

Mobile hotspots are now available for check out at the library. Come by or



Book Buzz


Where the Crawdads Sing by Delia Owens

For years, rumors of the “Marsh Girl” have haunted Barkley Cove, a quiet town on the North Carolina coast. So in late 1969, when handsome Chase Andrews is found dead, the locals immediately

suspect Kya Clark, the so-called Marsh Girl. But Kya is not what they say. Sensitive and intelligent, she has survived for years alone in the marsh that

she calls home, finding friends in the gulls and lessons in the sand.

Where the Crawdads Sing is at once an exquisite ode to the natural world, a heartbreaking coming-of-age story, and a surprising tale of possible murder. Owens reminds us that we are forever shaped by the children we once were, and that we are all subject to the beautiful and violent secrets that nature keeps.

HEAT Utility Assistance Program

The [Home Energy Assistance Target \(HEAT\)](#) program provides winter utility assistance to low-income households targeting those who are truly vulnerable – the lowest-income households with the highest heating costs, the disabled, elderly, and families with preschool-age children. This service is funded through the U.S. Department of Energy Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP).

This assistance is available between November and April. Appointments are scheduled on a first-come first-served basis beginning November 1st.

Winter Parking Restrictions

The winter parking restrictions are in effect until March 31, 2021. No parking on the street or City right-of-way is permitted between 10 p.m. and 7 a.m. The city assumes no liability for damage to personal property that occurs when it is placed in the city right-of-way (i.e. from snow plows).

During these winter months, please move your garbage and recycle cans off the edge of the street after garbage/recycle pick-up. The snowplows do the best they can to avoid striking them but, on some streets and in heavy snow, it can be difficult. Your assistance is appreciated.

And please clear your sidewalks after snow falls!
